

DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

We believe that:

- 1. The Scriptures are inspired by God and without error in the original manuscripts. They are the final authority for faith and conduct.
- 2. There is one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 3. Jesus Christ is truly God and truly man because He was begotten by God and born of the virgin Mary.
- 4. Jesus Christ died for the sins of every person. He was resurrected by the power of God. He ascended to heaven where He is now alive.
- 5. Man was created in the image of God. He sinned thereby incurring both physical and spiritual death which is separation from God.
- 6. Each individual must experience being born again of the Holy Spirit through personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, becoming a child of God.
- 7. God has called Christians to a life of conformity to the teachings of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit dwells in each believer to reproduce in each one the character of Jesus Christ.
